Library and Related Facilities: A Central Library having a collection of more than 39,170 books, adequate reading hall, three internet connected computers dedicated for students' purpose, latest Books and Magazines for competitive examinations (17), daily (6) and weekly (3) newspapers in both English and Bengali languages and **Central Research Laboratory** are available in our college. The Central Library is a member of **N-LIST** programme under **INFLIBNET** through which there is a facility to access more than 2,00,000 E-books and more than 6000 E-journals along with its membership of **National Digital Library** that facilitated the teachers and students to access almost endless e-reading materials.

Seminar/Outreach Programmes: The college organizes Seminars, Workshops etc. on a regular basis that inspires and enriches teachers, students and other stakeholders in and around our college locality. Many of the faculty members are actively engaged in dynamic research works performing as Principal Investigator and/or Research Guides. This college has adopted five villages namely, *Abasbari, Betkalla, Dhitai Bashan, Ghasipur and Kalikapur*—not too far from the college locality. The faculty members, non-teaching staff and students have participated as volunteers of NSS Units, Swachhata Action Plan (SAP) Teams under Swachh Bharat Mission during COVID-19 pandemic period and enthusiastically participated in environmental awareness programme, extension activities on several social issues like prevention of child marriage, dowry system and made people aware about various kinds of sources of air, water and noise pollution, its possible harmful effects and provided most plausible solutions.

Career Counselling: The college helps the students with appropriate guidance to establish linkages with the world of work and locate career opportunities *vis-à-vis* the realities and job profiles in the context of highly competitive emerging occupational patterns. The college also has the Satyendranath Tagore Civil Services Study Centre (SNTCCSSC, a Govt. of WB initiative) for preparation of Civil Services Examinations meant for all the eligible candidates of the district Purba Medinipur.

Sports and Allied Facilities: Adequate playground, sports equipments for major indoor and outdoor games, state-of-the-art gymnasium and above all appropriate guidance of the teachers of Physical Education Dept. are readily available in our college. This college, since long ago to till date, has a bright history of becoming Champion or Runner-up in University intercollege as well as district level Football, Volleyball, Kho-Kho etc. championships.

Hostel Facility: The Boys' Hostel and Girls' Hostels provide residential facilities to about forty and seventy undergraduate and postgraduate male and female students respectively.

Other Facilities:

- **ICT Enabled Class Rooms:** Seventeen departments have at least one Information and Communication Technology enabled Class Room.
- **Extra-curricular Activities:** Students participate in several extra-curricular activities like singing, dancing, recitation, debate, extempore, mock parliament, inter-college competitions in different fields, educational tours, excursions, observation of different important days, participation in NSS and NCC programmes, students' seminars are some to be mentioned. We are proud that in last few years our students frequently participated in Republic Day Parade, New Delhi.
- **Distance Education:** Our college has Study Centers of Rabindra Bharati University and Netaji Subhas Open University.
- **Common Rooms** The college has two Common Rooms, separately for boys and girls. Both common rooms have been developed with indoor games facilities like carrom, chess, table tennis, etc.
- **Wellness Centre:** The institution has established a health unit with first aid-facilities for the preliminary treatment and health check-up of students and staff of our college.
- **Seminar Room:** A modern and well-equipped Seminar Hall, with seating capacity of ~200 people, is present where the institution holds Seminars, Lectures and Workshops at regular intervals.
- **Auditorium:** The College has a spacious auditorium where more than 500 persons can assemble for cultural events. Presently, renovation works are going on.
- **Shooting Range:** We have a well-organized shooting range dedicated for NCC cadets. Our college has a glorious and brilliant past record of participation in National Cadet Corps (NCC) activities with our students' fullest passion, vigor and enthusiasm.
- **Canteen:** The college canteen is one of the most cheerful areas of the campus. It is spread over around 800 ft² area that accommodates about 100 users at a time including staff members and the students in separate sitting zones. Our canteen aims at providing a variety of quality food and beverages at moderately competitive rates.
- **Guest House:** The two-story startlingly decent guesthouse having 8 well-decorated and beautifully maintained rooms, is primarily meant for the official guests.
- **Car Parking & Cycle Stand:** There is a large cycle stand where more than hundred cycles can be accommodated in addition to a separate car parking zone.
