I. COURSE DESIGN

1. **Course Title** : Skills of Writing a Research Proposal
2. **Context** : This course aims to help the students to write a research proposal scientifically which is the base of any research work .
3. **Target Group** : Current Students of Semester-VI
4. **Course Objectives** :
 - i. To understand the basic concepts of research in social science.
 - ii. To understand the different techniques of identifying of research problems
 - iii. To know the different techniques of reviewing related literature
 - iv. To know the different techniques of formulating research objectives and research questions.
 - v. To know the different techniques and tools of data collection process
 - vi. To know the different techniques of sampling
 - vii. To give a hands on experience of writing a research proposal scientifically.
5. **Career Prospect** : The course will be helpful for the students willing to pursue higher degrees i.e. M.A. or Ph.D. where they have to be engaged actively on research work. The course will also be helpful for the students who will become teachers for writing research proposals for research projects or action researches.
6. **Faculty Requirements** : Departmental teacher(s).
7. **Mode of the Course** : Blended mode – theoretical classes through online mode and practical and evaluation through face-to-face mode.
8. **Course fees** : The course is free of cost.

9. **Intake capacity:** The intake capacity is around 70 students.

10. **Contact hours:** 30 hours (20 hours theory including 01 hour evaluation + 10 hours practical including two hours evaluation)

11. **Course duration:**

a. *Theoretical Component* : one class (lecture) = 01 hour

03 classes per day x 6 days = 18 hours

02 classes on the 7th day including 01 hour evaluation = 02 hours

b. *Practical component:* 02 classes per day x 4 days = 08 hours

02 hour for the evaluation on the 5th day = 02 hours

12. **Course content:** Detailed Syllabus is attached herewith in the Section - II.

13. **Course outcome:** On completion of the course the learners will be able to –

- *express the basic concepts of research in social science*
- *state the different techniques of identifying of research problems*
- *explain the different techniques of reviewing related literature*
- *write different techniques of formulating research objectives and research questions.*
- *say different techniques and tools of data collection process*
- *elaborate know the different techniques of sampling*
- *write a research proposal scientifically*

14. **Assessment Process and Grading:** The final Assessment will be based on both theoretical of 30 marks and practical of 20 marks. For theoretical component students have to answer 15 MCQs and 3 short answer type questions where as for practical they have to prepare a research proposal with at least 5 reviews of related literature. They have to give a presentation of their proposal also. Grading will be prepared by combining the marks obtained in both theoretical and practical components as follows:

96% to 100% - Grade- **AA** (Outstanding)

91% to 95% - Grade- **A+** (Excellent)
